GA-2023-91-RES-01

Subject: Membership of the Republic of Palau

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Vienna, Austria, from 28 November to 1 December 2023, at its 91st session:

BEARING IN MIND Article 4 of the Constitution and Resolution GA-2017-86-RES-01 on the process for membership of INTERPOL,

TAKING NOTE of the application for membership dated 26 January 2023 submitted by the President of the Republic of Palau,

CONSIDERING the contents of the application by the Republic of Palau and the requirements of membership including the understanding of the Republic of Palau of the obligations under Articles 2 to 7 and 31 to 33 of the Constitution,

CONSIDERING that, upon becoming a Member and in compliance with Article 32 of the Constitution, the Republic of Palau shall appoint a body which will serve as the National Central Bureau,

DECIDES that:

- The Republic of Palau shall be a Member of the Organization with effect from the present session of the General Assembly;
- The Republic of Palau shall be part of Asia for the purposes of participation in the regional conferences and geographical distribution within the Executive Committee;
- The contribution of the Republic of Palau for the year 2024 shall be determined by the scale of distribution of statutory contributions, as approved by a resolution of the General Assembly. The exact amount of its contribution will be communicated in due course;

TASKS the Secretary General to implement, in compliance with the existing rules, rights of access to the INTERPOL Information System of the National Central Bureau to be designated by the Republic of Palau.
